While this pandemic hit hard around the world, we learned that many organizations were not able to send support as their churches were struggling themselves. Many of our Guatemalan partners were informed that their support was no longer available. All mission teams and vision groups were cancelled. Even still, our leaders in Guatemala were able to continue serving and ministering in their communities. The Guatemalan government has imposed various curfews throughout the year, including complete nationwide quarantine on the weekends. Now, the country has opened their economy and borders with restrictions.

# **NATHALIE'S STORY:**

Global Faith Network has seen testimonies of light as darkness grew: we learned that little Nathalie needed to have urgent surgery as her smile was fading away from kidney cancer. Guatemalan pastor, Erwin Luna, from Tesoros de Gracia, and a group of generous Guatemalans helped her to get the money for surgery in-country along with donors in the USA.

As Nathalie recovers more and more each day, we see glimpses of hope. Today, 3 year old Nathalie continues smiling due to the generosity of the body of Christ.



Our mission is simple and clear. We understand the importance of connecting resources by engaging people. For the past 10 months during this pandemic, we have been connecting with donors incountry at one of the largest markets in Guatemala City: CENMA. They have been partnering with us by providing fresh fruits



and vegetables every week to hundreds of people and families. We provide the labor, transportation, and all of the resources to make sure the communities that we serve receive this blessing.

VISION TRIPS: As we learn more about the travel restrictions and requirements to get back to Guatemala safely, we will keep you updated on how it develops.

As of October 1, 2020, Guatemala has their borders open and the state of calamity/emergency is no longer in place, nor are curfews. Social distancing and the use of masks are still in place as a requirement to be able to walk freely with in Guatemala. We will let you know when and how will be a good time to visit the ministries in Guatemala again.









#### **HOW CAN YOU HELP?**

- Pray for the safety for our Ministry partners; their spiritual, emotional and physical health as they continue working the streets of Guatemala.
- Help us provide Pastor Shorty and the rehab house with more materials for their bakery. These men have not only learned to bake, but also how to give back. They've done this by donating their bread to the pastors and community.
- A donation of \$500.00 per month will:
  - Provide 11,000 loaves of bread and cookies for 700 families from Pastor Erwin Luna's (Shorty's) churches and communities we partner with. This will also help the restoration of the men living at the rehab as they continue to learn a trade and work on the transformation of their own lives.
  - Help Pastor Rafa's son, Erick, with his carpentry shop to teach young people to learn the trade. This gives young people an income as they can sell what they make, and help restore the homes of the families of the communities that are in need.
  - Allow GFN to provide a bag of non-perishable food items to 30 families.
  - Allow GFN to distribute and deliver purified water to 750 families per month, especially the families that do not have access to clean drinking water in their communities.


